

# Coach Specific Training for NLP Master Practitioners

**4/5 November 2010, 13/14 January 2011 & 31 March/1 April 2011**

Anyone who has done NLP Masters will have acquired many of the skills that they need to be a good coach, however, NLP training is not recognised as coach specific training by any of the coaching professional bodies. Until now people had to go back to square one and attend a basic coaching programme that would not take account of all of your prior learning.

Our coach programme has been designed to provide qualifying NLP Master Practitioners with the "Coach Specific Training" needed to apply for accreditation with either the International Coaching Federation (ICF) or the Association for Coaching (AC).

This coach programme will assume all of your prior knowledge and experience and give you the "missing pieces" of Coach Specific Training to apply for accreditation as a coach. It will cover the core competencies, hours and assessment required by both ICF and AC.

It is likely that there will be legislation over the next few years regulating the coaching, counselling and therapy professions. Also, with the growth of the coaching profession and the development of professional bodies accreditation is becoming a baseline standard.

## **Eligibility**

This programme is open to anyone who has a NLP Master Practitioner Certification and has completed a minimum of 240 hours of NLP training.

## **The Programme**

This programme will be delivered in a practical, interactive and enjoyable way. You will be encouraged to focus on real situations and the objectives which you want to achieve. The group will be kept small (maximum 15 people) to ensure interactivity and participation.

We take the view that people are whole beings. We will work at multiple levels to give you the training and development to integrate NLP with excellent coaching standards and practice.

## **Programme Requirements**

A separate briefing document is available detailing the programme requirements which will satisfy the programme assessment. Many of these will also form part of your application for accreditation with Association for Coaching (AC) and/or International Coach Federation (ICF). In summary they are:

- Log 18 hours coaching during the programme. This needs to be with a minimum of 4 people, for a minimum of 3 x 1hr sessions.
- Attend supervision with an appropriately qualified person for a minimum 6 x 1hr sessions during the programme. This is at additional cost and for you to arrange.
- Attend a total 60 hours coach specific training – this requires 100% attendance at all sessions, tutorials and triad meetings (see below). In the event that you miss any component you may "catch-up" a maximum of 4 hours. A day is set aside for catch up.
- Record 1 live coaching session, provide a transcript and critique.
- Maintain a learning log and provide a 1000 - 1200 word summary to be submitted on the final Module
- Be a part of a triad of course participants and "meet" face to face or by telephone for 5 sessions for a minimum of 2½ hours.
- Produce a statement of your approach to coaching and your coaching philosophy.
- There is a required reading list.
- Demonstrate required competencies and ethical behaviours.

## Assessment

There will be continuous assessment, required reading, a case study and observed practice during the final two days of the programme.

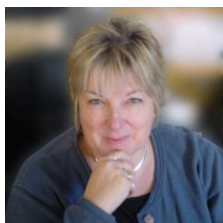
## Additional Requirements for Accreditation
