Training is more than a role or a set of skills. The average competent trainer and many trainer trainings focus only on skills and behaviour, the exceptional trainer knows it is more significantly about how and who they are.

They understand that training and what happens in a group is not about them. They learn to become "an empty flute" and at the same time, and seemingly paradoxically, manifest themselves through the training they do.

This is a NLP Trainer Training that is not only about how to train NLP skills, it is also a training for those who are skilled in NLP and want to become exceptional trainers, presenters and facilitators whatever the content.

Participants will have plenty of opportunity to present and receive feedback during the modules and will be set tasks and assignments throughout the programme including videoing training sessions or presentations and bringing them to the group for comment and feedback. Thus we will ensure you are fluent in essential training skills and group dynamics. There will also be the opportunity to model a number of excellent guest trainers.

During the programme you will:

- Identify your own edge for learning
- Have many chances to run sessions and receive high quality feedback
- Develop and find your authentic presence as a trainer
- Understand and fully appreciate your personal impact on the group
- Develop your ability to role model what you are training, teaching or presenting
- Learn to work skilfully with process, as well as content
- Work with and use the dynamics of a group
- Discover the presuppositions of excellent trainers
- Learn to align logical levels
- Revisit your knowledge of NLP from a trainer's perspective
- Teach & demonstrate NLP exceptionally
- Handle open frames, difficult behaviours and give challenging feedback
- Develop platform skills and your use of stage anchors
- Model exceptional trainers
- Be challenged and have fun!

We take a whole systems approach, creating a context where you will live your learning. With a maximum of 15, the individual and group process will also become the content for learning and understanding group dynamics.

The programme will be lead by Marie Faire with guest trainers throughout the programme, including Richard Tyler and Liz and Ian Newton.

She is co- founder and a director of The Beyond Partnership and has been leading Practitioner and Master Practitioner NLP trainings for many years. In addition to being an NLP trainer, Marie has a MA in Management Learning. She also has extensive training in humanistic psychology and group dynamics; has trained in Covey "7 Habits" & the Enneagram and is certified in Spiral Dynamics and various psychometric tests, including FIRO B and MBTI (Step 1 and 2).

Eligibility

The Beyond Trainer Training is designed for NLP Master Practitioners who want to make a step change in their ability to work with and lead groups. Participants need to already have completed 40 days training in NLP and have some training or presenting experience.
